Apple day is a national fundraising event that helps support Scouting at all levels. All members of the 28th Ottawa are encouraged to attend this important event. **75% of the funds we collect remain with our group!**

We don't sell apples on Apple Day; we request donations for Scouts Canada, in return for an apple.

Parents, please remember that **Beavers and Cubs are often the most effective Apple Day participants**. There will be a minimum of 2 leaders at each location at all times.

You will be contacted by your section coordinator to set up the time and place that you will attend.

- ❑ 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM on Saturday, October 5, 2012

We will be spread out over a few locations in Alta Vista/Trainyards area. The list of locations will be given to leaders and sign-up sheets will be available as this week. We suggest that older youth participate for 2-3 hours, and younger Beavers participate for 1-2 hours. Please come when you can, for as long as you can.

Bring an apple/fruit basket (the 3 or 4 liter size is best) and a donation collection container (margarine container, water bottle, empty coffee can with plastic lid). Wear your uniform. Please ensure that it is clean and in good condition as you will be representing Scouting and the 28th Ottawa to the public. If it is cold, make sure that you bring a warm jacket and gloves.

Remember to approach everyone with courtesy, politeness, and a smile. Suggested phrases include:

- a) **Would you like to support Scouting and enjoy an apple?**
- b) **Today is Apple Day – please support Scouting.**

If someone asks “**how much?**” the reply should be “**As much as you care to give**”. **Apples are not sold by the basket**. Apples are given as a token of appreciation. People don't have to take the apple.
